**PENOBSCOT.**

Situated twenty-two miles S. W. from Ellsworth, Bucksport and their line stage line, and former trading post and a large part of Brooks trading house established in 1626 by Plymouth Colony, which was abandoned in a few years. Dr. Anson, a Penobscot, established himself here in 1640. In 1656 Baron de Castine came to the place, and in 1657 married a daughter of Massachusetts, and the town was named in his honor. First permanent settlement was made by the English in the spring of 1760. Penobscot was incorporated February 23, 1787. Incorporated as a town in 1800. Population in 1880, 1341.
